3. The crime scene inspection in terrorism crime (included bioterrorism), drug trafficking and other serious crime of global impact.
4. Digital technologies implementation to Cyber-crime forensic investigation and other several elements that come from the crime scene.
5. Reconstruction and simulation through the use of techniques of computer science techniques for the criminal investigation. Development trends in forensic infographics.
6. Photographic treatment to the expert investigations in the crime scene and the implementation of digital images in the expert report and the evidence of the crime.
7. Expert investigation of breakdowns, explosions and fires in industries and complex economic objectives.

General Subject Matters of the Biometric Identification Conference:

1. Development updating of computing-biometrics software for the investigation, protection and safety.
2. Implementation of digital technologies to the biometric identification in a wider spectrum of the criminal investigation and the crime enforcement.
